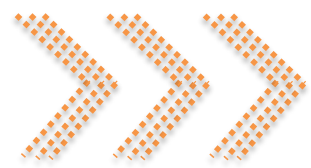

PROCUREMENT LEVELS

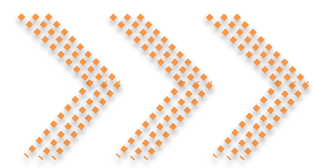
- Level 1 - Purchases up to \$999.99
- Level 2 - Purchases between \$1,000.00 and \$9,999.99
- Level 3 - Purchases between \$10,000 and \$24,999.99
- Level 4 - Purchases between \$25,000.00 and \$49,999.99
- Level 5 - Purchases of \$50,000.00 and up



PRIMARY SOLICITATION PROCESSES

1. Competitive sealed bid or low bid process
2. Competitive sealed proposals or RFP process
3. Selection of professional consultants through the Consultants Competitive Negotiations Act (CCNA) as governed by F.S. § 287.055.

Other procurement methods include cooperative purchases (piggybacking), emergency purchases, sole and single source purchases and direct contracts with state, county or municipal governments and state colleges and universities.
