



In anticipation of the six-year I-4 Ultimate project, the Central Florida Expressway Authority Board approved relief measures for commuters looking for I-4 alternatives during construction.

#### Two main focuses of the program:

1. Reduce the cost for customers to open an E-PASS by 40%
2. Provide discounts to regular E-PASS customer commuters  
*Discount covers approximately 1 day of tolls per month for the average commuter.*

#### What is E-PASS?

E-PASS is a hassle-free way to drive on toll roads throughout Florida, North Carolina and Georgia. Customers create a pre-paid account and receive a small electronic sticker that attaches to the windshield inside their car. Each time the customer passes through a toll it's electronically debited from their account. A record of the transactions are included in their monthly statements.

#### E-PASS Facts + Benefits

- FREE for residents of Brevard, Lake, Orange, Osceola, Polk, Seminole and Volusia Counties
- E-PASS customers pay an average of 23% less on most tolls than those paying cash
- E-PASS customers save 27 hours in annual travel time and \$259 in annual travel costs
- The minimum balance in prepaid tolls to open an E-PASS account is now \$15 (was \$25)
- Each additional vehicle only requires an addition \$10 in prepaid tolls (was \$25)

#### E-PASS Beltway Discounts as of July 1, 2015

- E-PASS customers who pay 20 or more tolls in a month will receive a 5% discount on Orange County portions of the beltway (SR 417, SR 429, SR 414) operated by CFX.
- These commuter relief discounts are in addition to the existing volume discounts:

	Volume Discount	Beltway Discount*	Total Discount
20-39 CFX Beltway tolls		5%	5%
40-79 CFX Beltway tolls	5%	5%	10%
80+ CFX Beltway tolls	10%	5%	15%

\*Conditioned on actual revenues trending 2%+ above March, 2015 projections for the 6 year construction period. Beltway discount only applies to CFX portions of SR 417, SR 429 and SR 414.
