






2030 Master Plan


• Completed in 2006

- \$4.8 billion in potential expansion projects






2030 Master Plan Existing System Improvements






2030 Master Plan Potential Expansion Projects



Existing System Improvements

- Capacity
 - Roadway widening
- Traffic Operations
 - Interchange and ramp intersection improvements
- System Renewal Needs
 - Road resurfacing, facilities and equipment

Based on technical analysis of system statistics, history, life-cycle and T&R coordination



Revenue / Tolling Options

- Toll rate policy
 - Future toll rate adjustments
- Toll collection technology and operations
 - Emerging technologies

Board input critical for development and evaluation of opportunities and constraints



Expansion Projects

- New expressway routes
- New interchanges

Board and Stakeholder input necessary for identification and evaluation of expansion options

Multi-Modal Transportation Role

2014 CFX legislation created major opportunities for multi-modal projects..

"The term "Central Florida Expressway System" means any expressway... <u>and any rapid transit, trams or fixed</u> <u>guideways located within the right of way of an</u> <u>expressway</u>"

- Two phase approach
- Phase One (Completed in December 2013)
 - Data collection
 - Existing system analysis
 - Coordination with 15 Stakeholders

Sample of Stakeholder Input

- Orange County very interested in future projects in the eastern part of the county
- City of Orlando recommended the Authority become involved in developing and funding multi-modal options
- Lake County discussed the status of the Wellness Way Sector Plan and interest in improving east-west connections
- Seminole County suggested advancing the widening of SR 417
- Osceola County shared information on the various sector plans in the northern potion of the county

- Greater Orlando Aviation Authority shared plans and schedule of the south intermodal terminal
- Metroplan Orlando shared schedule of the 2040 Long Range Transportation Plan


