CONSTRUCTION COULCK FACTS

PROJECT: SR 429/NEW INDEPENDENCE PARKWAY INTERCHANGE IMPROVEMENTS

To improve traffic flow, the Central Florida
Expressway Authority is partnering with Orange
County to make improvements at the SR 429/New
Independence Parkway interchange. The project
consists of widening the southbound off ramp to New
Independence Parkway and adding traffic lights,
pedestrian signals and street lighting on New
Independence Parkway over SR 429.

LANE CLOSURES

During construction, temporary lane closures may be necessary to accommodate work. To minimize the impact of construction to motorists traveling on SR 429 and New Independence Parkway, lane closures will not be permitted during peak travel times. There will be night and weekend work on this project.

WORK ZONE SAFETY

For the safety of motorists and work crews, speed limits will be strictly enforced during construction. Speeding fines are doubled in work zones when workers are present. Motorists are reminded to change lanes for safety when they see Road Rangers assisting other motorists or flashing lights – it's Florida law.
