A RESOLUTION OF THE CENTRAL FLORIDA EXPRESSWAY AUTHORITY AMENDING THE POLICY FOR FREE TRANSPONDERS

WHEREAS, Central Florida Expressway Authority ("CFX") is desirous of enhancing its electronic toll collection program in order to enhance traffic safety, reduce operational costs, and increase customer value and service offerings; and

WHEREAS, as part of its efforts to enhance its electronic toll collection program, CFX is purchasing bulk quantities of transponders which can be affixed to vehicles; and

WHEREAS, CFX plans to sponsor promotional giveaways of these transponders in order to attract new customers who will pay for system usage electronically while providing them opportunities for customer loyalty programs; and

WHEREAS, the CFX governing Board previously determined that the logical class of future electronic customers eligible for promotional free transponders should be vehicle owners who are domiciled or have business addresses in the six counties which are geographically contiguous and encompass or border the CFX system i.e. Orange, Seminole, Osceola, Polk, Brevard, Volusia and Lake; and

WHEREAS, in order to maximize the electronic toll collection program on the CFX system the Board now determines that free transponders should be made available to customers regardless of domicile; and

WHEREAS, all public notice requirements necessary for adoption have been fulfilled.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CENTRAL FLORIDA EXPRESSWAY AUTHORITY as follows:

Section 1. All registered owners of vehicles shall be eligible for issuance of free transponders provided such recipients shall be required to complete the appropriate CFX application process establishing a new account as an E-PASS customer. Existing E-PASS customers shall also be eligible for issuance of free transponders. A free transponder can be obtained whether it is for a new account, a new vehicle on an existing account or a replacement for an existing vehicle on an existing account. Any further eligibility requirements necessary and consistent with the above shall be made at the discretion of the CFX Executive Director and promulgated as procedure.

Section 2. <u>CODIFICATION</u>. This policy shall be codified in Chapter 2, Section 2-1, of the CFX Permanent Policies and Procedures and replaces Resolution 2016-352 which is hereby repealed.

Section 3. <u>EFFECTIVE DATE</u>. This Policy shall become effective upon adoption by the CFX governing Board.
