



#### **CFX AT A GLANCE**

The Central Florida Expressway
Authority (CFX) is an independent,
locally-controlled toll agency
responsible for construction,
maintenance and operation of 125
miles of expressway.

CFX serves more than 3 million residents in five counties, plus an estimated 75 million visitors each year. Established in 2014 as a regional expressway authority; membership includes the City of Orlando, and Brevard, Lake, Orange, Osceola, and Seminole counties.

All CFX operations are funded solely by tolls - CFX does not receive state or federal tax dollars. Tolls collected on CFX expressways are reinvested locally, funding the maintenance, operations and construction of our expressway system.



#### **MISSION**

To build, operate and maintain a mobility network through accountability, fiscally sound practices and a community focus.

#### VISION

To provide the region with a world-class, integrated mobility network that drives economic prosperity and quality of life.

#### **GOVERNING BOARD**

CFX 's 10-member Board is made up of a representative from Brevard, Lake, Orange, Osceola, and Seminole county commissions, the mayors of Orlando and Orange County and three governor's appointees. Florida's Turnpike Enterprise serves as a non-voting adviser to the Board. Public meetings give residents the opportunity to participate and are held monthly. Meeting schedules are posted on CFXway.com.
