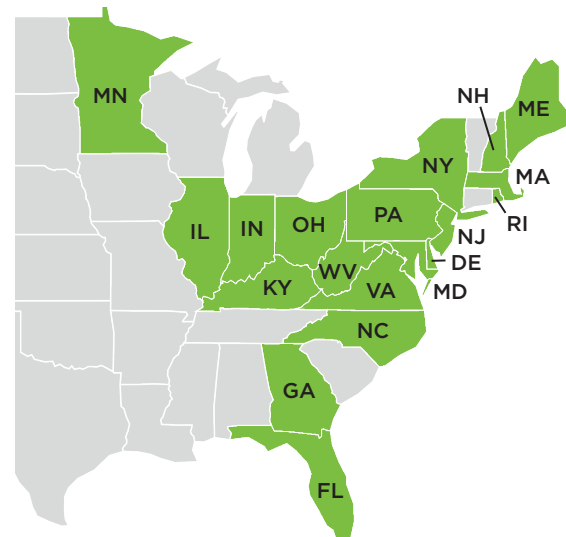


Where your Uni works

5 Types of Tolling Lanes in Florida

Open Road Tolling Lanes



A large overhead gantry allows you to travel at highway speeds while the tolls are deducted from your Prepaid Account. If no transponder is detected, the toll will be billed on a Pay By Plate Invoice and includes an administrative charge.

E-PASS/SunPass Only Lanes



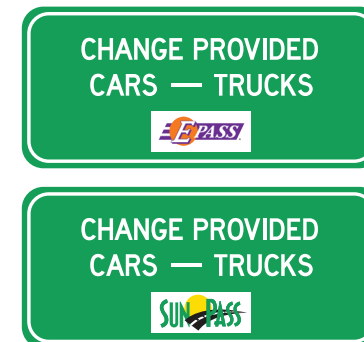
Exclusive use for customers with a transponder. Posted speed is 25 mph, tolls are deducted from your Prepaid Account.

Exact Change Lanes



Is only for cars (two axle vehicles). Trucks (3+ axles) and trailers are not permitted in this lane.

Change/Receipt/Ticket Lanes



Attended lanes that can be used by all customers.

Reload Lanes



Attended customer service lanes that can be used to reload your E-PASS account or get E-PASS

*E-PASS Portable is no longer available. Uni is now the portable toll pass option from E-PASS.
