PROJECT DEVELOPMENT AND ENVIRONMENT STUDY

CFX is conducting a Project Development and Environment (PD&E) Study for capacity improvements on eastbound and westbound SR 408 between Kirkman Road and Church Street.

STUDY DESCRIPTION

More than 164,000 vehicles per day travel on SR 408 near downtown Orlando. This study has evaluated alternatives for improving traffic flow by adding a travel lane in each direction on SR 408 from Kirkman Road to Church Street. If approved for construction, most of the work would occur within the existing SR 408 right of way.

STUDY GOALS

The goals of the SR 408 Capacity Improvements between Kirkman Road and Church Street PD&E Study include:

- Enhancing mobility for the area's growing population and economy.
- Providing consistency with local plans and policies.

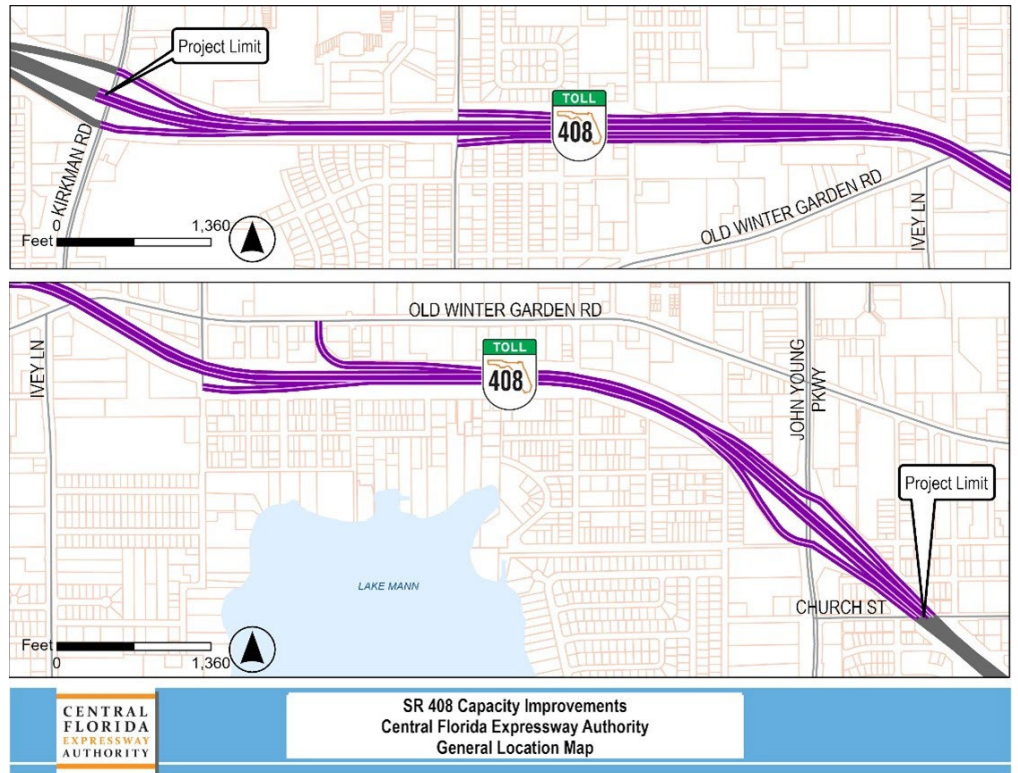
