SECTION 1 – INTRODUCTION

The Central Florida Expressway Authority (CFX) began conducting the Project Development and Environment (PD&E) Study for the State Road 429/Binion Road Interchange in August 2022. The PD&E study evaluated a proposed half interchange (northbound entrance ramp and southbound exit ramp) expressway connection from Binion Road to SR 429.

Proposed alternatives include the addition of a signalized intersection or roundabout at the intersection of SR 429/South Binion Road/Boy Scout Road. The study, coordinated with the City of Apopka, analyzed intersection improvements and access management modifications to provide enhanced access and mobility to southwest Apopka.

PROJECT BACKGROUND

This study was included in CFX's five-year work program following discussions with City of Apopka officials in 2021.

Currently, drivers must enter and exit SR 429 by traveling approximately three miles north to just north of US 441 at the SR 429 Connector Road interchange or travel three miles south to the interchange at Ocoee Apopka Road/County Road 437A.

The proposed SR 429/Binion Road Interchange would consist of a new half interchange (northbound entrance ramp and southbound exit ramp) expressway connection from Binion Road to SR 429. Proposed alternatives include the addition of a signalized intersection or roundabout at the intersection of SR 429/South Binion Road/Boy Scout Road. A noise analysis was conducted as part of the study.

The general objective of the PD&E study was to provide information necessary for CFX to reach a decision on the viability of each alternative.

SECTION 2 – STAKEHOLDER COORDINATION AND MEETINGS

2.1 LOCAL GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS

The Public Involvement Program involved identifying and communicating with state, regional, and local agencies having a potential interest in this project due to jurisdictional review or expressed interest.

A kick-off letter to inform local, state, and regional officials about the project was sent on October 7, 2022. Elected and appointed officials were provided notice of the one public meeting.

Formal presentations were made to local official boards to gain input and to provide study updates as follows:

- City of Apopka Coordination Meeting – 9/13/2022
- City of Apopka and Ridge Development Coordination Meeting – 10/17/22
- Apopka City Council Meeting – 10/19/2022

- **September 13, 2022, City of Apopka:** The purpose of this meeting was to discuss the status of the study and schedule a date to present in front of the Apopka City Council.
- **October 17, 2022, City of Apopka and Ridge Development:** The purpose of this meeting was to discuss the upcoming City Council meeting on October 19, 2022 and the status of the Ridge Development in coordination with the study.
- **October 19, 2022, Apopka City Council:** The purpose of this meeting was to provide an update on the study and gain input from the Commissioners and City staff.

2.2 PUBLIC INVOLVEMENT AND MEETINGS

The Public Involvement Plan (PIP) included conducting a kick-off mailing and one public meeting to present the latest study information and to gather vital feedback from the public.

Project Kick-Off

On October 7, 2022, an informational project kick-off letter, public meeting invitation and fact sheet were mailed and/or emailed to the following:

- Nearly 300 property owners and tenants along the study corridor;
- 25 elected officials; and
- 39 appointed government officials.

One public meeting was conducted.

Public Meeting

The Public Meeting was held in-person on Thursday, November 3, 2022 from 5:30 p.m. – 7:30 p.m. at Apopka High School's cafeteria.

Public meeting invitations were sent with the initial kick-off letters on October 7, 2022 to 25 elected officials and their aides and 39 local, regional, state and federal agency contacts. They were also mailed to 272 property owners and tenants along the corridor.

On October 21, 2022 an invitation reminder was emailed to 25 elected officials, 39 local, regional, state and federal agency contacts, and three people who asked to be added to the study's database. A door-to-door outreach was also conducted on Friday, October 28, where approximately 70 public meeting invitations were delivered to residents and businesses along the corridor. In addition to this, an email was sent out to property management companies for residential communities along the corridor.

Legal advertisements were published in the *Apopka Chief* on Friday, October 21 and Friday, October 28 and in the Orange County edition of the *Orlando Sentinel* on Sunday, October 23 and Sunday, October 30.

An ad was published in the *Florida Administrative Register* (FAR) on Thursday, October 20, 2022, and a media advisory was distributed to local media outlets on Thursday, October 27, 2022.

Nearly 20 people attended the in-person meeting where a looped video presentation provided an overview of the study process, history and details of the alternatives. Attendees were able to ask study

team members questions and provide written comments. One written comment was submitted during the meeting.

2.3 SUMMARY OF PUBLIC COMMENTS

Seven comments and questions were received during the public meeting's 10-day comment period.

Most questions were from residents seeking clarification about what to expect regarding the construction timeline, noise mitigation and various safety precautions for homes, drivers, and pedestrians. The information below reflects the general nature of the comments and questions received.

- Was there consideration for a full interchange versus just the half interchange being proposed now?
- The roundabout seems the better option for traffic flow.
- We think this is a great idea to remove congestion on Binion Road. The traffic circle seems to accomplish this best.
- The proposed half interchange doesn't address the needs of the growing population, we ask you consider a full interchange or flipping the configuration for easier access to SR 414.

Comments submitted during the public meeting and those mailed or emailed prior to Monday, November 14, 2022, have been included as part of the public record.


Public involvement and interagency coordination will be an integral part of the study. CFX will hold one public meeting during this six-month study. Details for the meeting are available below.

In August 2022, CFX began a Project Development and Environment (PD&E) Study of the SR 429/Binion Road Interchange. The study is evaluating a proposed half interchange (northbound entrance ramp and southbound exit ramp) expressway connection from Binion Road to SR 429 to provide enhanced access and mobility to southwest Apopka. A noise analysis will be conducted as part of the study.

STUDY DESCRIPTION

The study area runs along the vicinity of South Binion Road and Boy Scout Road at SR 429. Currently, drivers must enter and exit SR 429 by traveling approximately three miles north to just north of US 441 at the SR 429 Connector Road interchange or travel three miles south to the interchange at Ocoee Apopka Road.

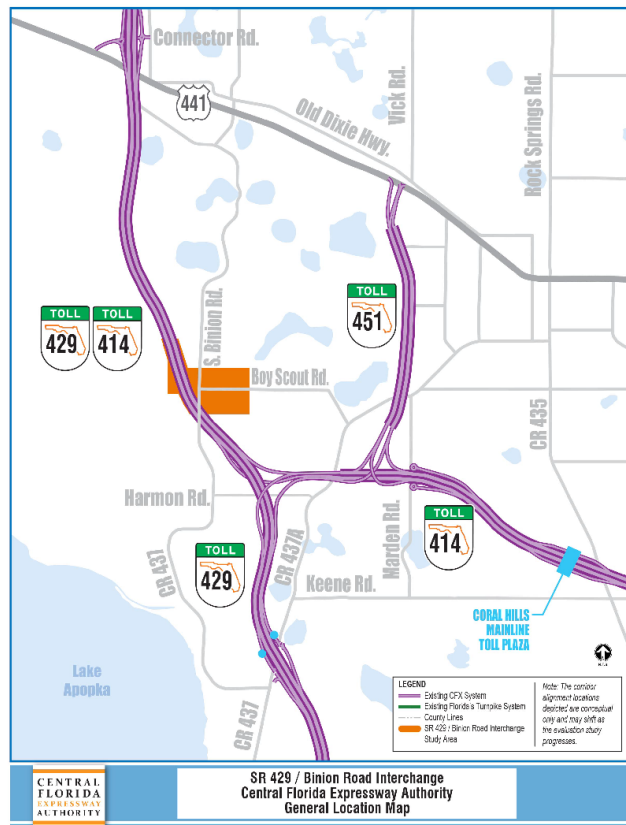
The 6-month study will analyze intersection improvements and access management modifications along the proposed interchange.

This meeting was held to allow the community to view and submit their comments on the intersection alternatives and other study materials.

I. Study Background

In August 2022, CFX began a Project Development and Environment (PD&E) Study of the SR 429/Binion Road Interchange. The study is evaluating a proposed half interchange (northbound entrance ramp and southbound exit ramp) expressway connection from Binion Road to SR 429.

The proposed half interchange runs along the vicinity of South Binion Road and Boy Scout Road at SR 429. Currently, drivers must enter and exit SR 429 by traveling approximately three miles north to just north of US 441 at the SR 429 Connector Road interchange, or travel three miles south to the interchange at Ocoee Apopka Road/County Road 437A. Proposed alternatives include the addition of a signalized intersection or roundabout at the intersection of SR 429/South Binion Road/Boy Scout Road. A noise analysis will be conducted as part of the study.

The PD&E Study, coordinated with the City of Apopka, will analyze intersection improvements and access management modifications to provide enhanced access and mobility to southwest Apopka.

II. Study Methodology

CFX is following FDOT's PD&E Manual. This study will result in a Level 1 Project Environmental Impact Report (PEIR) with CFX's approval. This study will analyze and document physical, natural, social, and cultural impacts.

Public involvement and interagency coordination are integral to the assessment process, and multiple opportunities for participation are being provided. In September 2022, a kick-off mailing with information about the study was sent to over 300 property owners, residents, and elected and appointed officials along the study corridor. One public meeting was held to collect vital public input on the two interchange options under evaluation.

Public comments received during this Public Meeting, as well as from stakeholders, local agencies, officials, and other interested parties during the study, will be considered in the evaluation of the project.

III. Public Notification

Public meeting invitation letters were sent on Friday, October 21, by email to 25 elected officials; 39 local, regional, state, and federal agency contacts; and three people who asked to be added to the study's database. They were also mailed to 272 property owners and tenants along the corridor.

Door-to-door outreach was conducted on Friday, October 28, where approximately 70 public meeting invitations were delivered to residents and businesses along the corridor.

IV. Media Notification

The public meeting was advertised in the Apopka Chief on Friday, October 21 and Friday, October 28, 2022. It was also advertised in the Orange County edition of the Orlando Sentinel on Sunday, October 23 and Sunday, October 30, 2022.

An ad was published in the *Florida Administrative Register* (FAR) on Thursday, October 20, 2021, and a media advisory was distributed to local media outlets on Thursday, October 27, 2022.

V. Public Meeting Agenda

The meeting was held at Apopka High School with an open-house format. Meeting attendees were able to view maps illustrating the project study area and a looped video presentation provided an overview of the study process, history and details of the alternatives. Attendees were able to ask study team members questions and provide written comments.

VIII. Public Comments

One comment was received during the public meeting; CFX received an additional six comments via email by November 14, 2022.

Most questions were from residents seeking clarification about what to expect regarding construction timeline, sound mitigation and various safety precautions for homes, drivers, and pedestrians. The information below reflects the general nature of the comments and questions received.

- Was there consideration for a full interchange versus just the half interchange being proposed now?

- The roundabout seems the better option for traffic flow.
- We think this is a great idea to remove congestion on Binion Road. The traffic circle seems to accomplish this best.
- The proposed half interchange doesn't address the needs of the growing population, we ask you consider a full interchange or flipping the configuration for easier access to SR 414.

Comments submitted during the public meeting and those mailed or emailed prior to Monday, November 14, 2022, have been included as part of the public record.

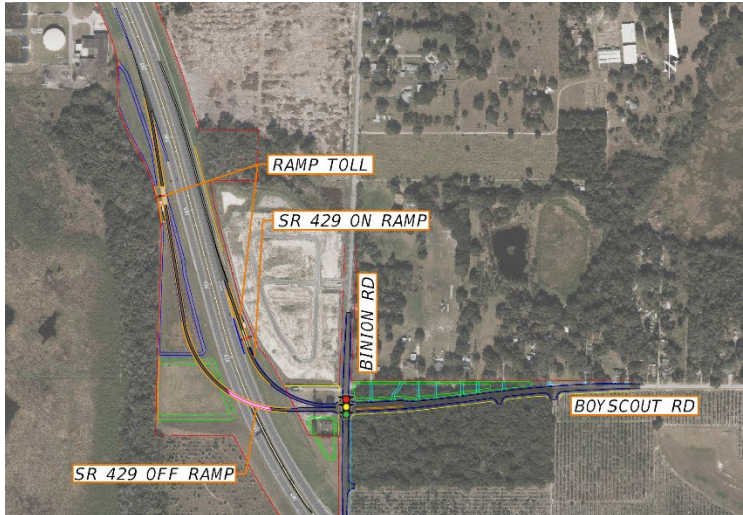

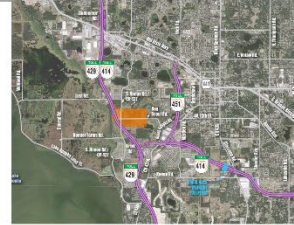

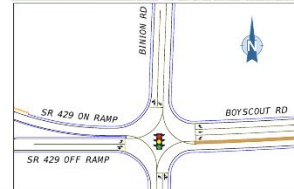

SR 429/Binion Road Option 1: Proposed Signalized Intersection

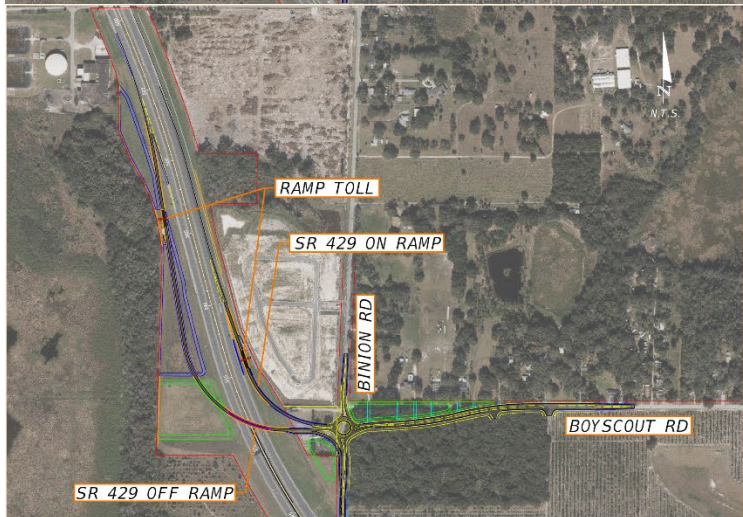

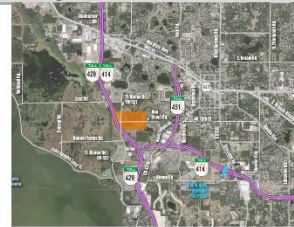

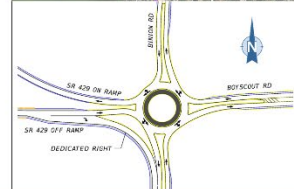

Thanks again for all of the additional information regarding this project. While I don't in any way pretend to be an expert in road design or traffic studies, a couple of ideas that come to mind for a full interchange would be as follows:

- 1.) Utilize a setup similar to Marden Rd/SR414 with a roundabout on either side of 429 with a light installed at the intersection of Binion & Boy Scout. This would allow for both southbound/northbound entrance and exit with minimal additional land usage, and would also allow for existing 3rd lanes from 414 to 429 to play a role in ingress/egress on the south end of this interchange. (see Proposal #1)
- 2.) Similar roundabout setup as proposed currently, but with southbound 429 access instead of northbound. (see Proposal #2)

After talking with quite a few residents in the area regarding the proposed changes to this intersection, the vast majority of people express the same concerns that I do; Binion to northbound 429 and southbound 429 to Binion would be heavily under-utilized. The vast majority of traffic at both the 441/429 interchange and Ocoee-Apopka/429 interchange is traveling south on 429 or heading towards east 414 into Orlando. The current distance from Clear Lake Landing subdivision to 414/429 is 2.7 miles which is the closest access point to north 429, while it's 3.6 miles to Ocoee-Apopka/429 to head south. It's also 3 miles exactly to the Marden Rd entrance on 414 heading eastbound.

It is my belief that allowing traffic to flow to and from south 429 would alleviate growing traffic concerns at both Ocoee-Apopka/429 interchange as well as Marden Rd/Ocoee-Apopka which becomes very congested during rush hour due to that being the closest point for this side of

Good morning Mr. Camara,

Unfortunately I have a prior engagement this evening and won't be able to make the meeting at the school this evening, but I did have a clarification question I would like to present if you have some time to answer please.

The documentation that I am reading shows "northbound entrance" and "southbound exit" but the way the roads are described makes it sound like northbound entrance from SR-429 to Binion and Southbound exit from Binion to SR-429. The map would seemingly indicate the opposite is true, that the entrance would be northbound from Binion onto SR-429 and the exit would be southbound SR-429 to Binion. Which of these is the proposed setup?

If my suspicion is correct and it's the latter, I would ask why the former would not be considered? Within our community, I know the vast majority of people utilizing 429 currently are typically traveling southbound or they are utilizing Marden Rd entrance to 414 eastbound. It would seem to me that a southbound entrance from Binion to 429 would make the most sense as the traffic is ever increasing along Marden with the new school and apartments and the current entrance at Ocoee-Apopka between Binion and Keene is becoming more and more congested. The current intersection at 441 and 429 appears to be more than adequate for northbound traffic and is closer to the communities along Binion than the closest southbound entrance to 429.

Thanks again for all of the additional information regarding this project. While I don't in any way pretend to be an expert in road design or traffic studies, a couple of ideas that come to mind for a full interchange would be as follows:

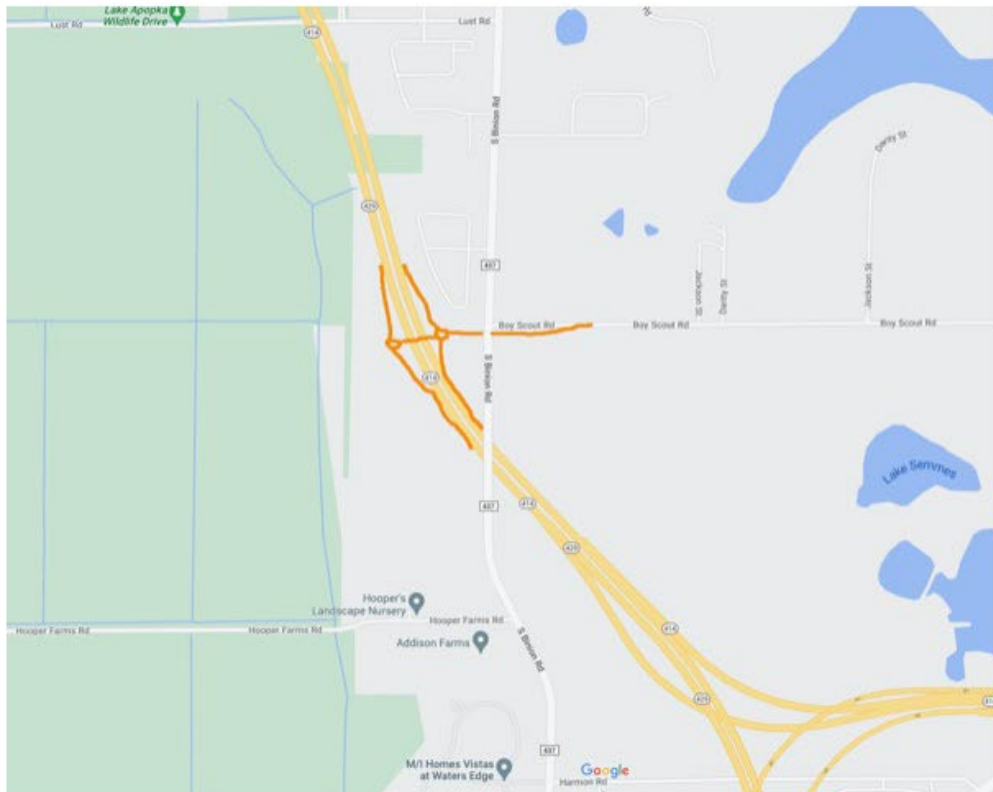
- 1.) Utilize a setup similar to Marden Rd/SR414 with a roundabout on either side of 429 with a light installed at the intersection of Binion & Boy Scout. This would allow for both southbound/northbound entrance and exit with minimal additional land usage, and would also allow for existing 3rd lanes from 414 to 429 to play a role in ingress/egress on the south end of this interchange. (see Proposal #1)
- 2.) Similar roundabout setup as proposed currently, but with southbound 429 access instead of northbound. (see Proposal #2)

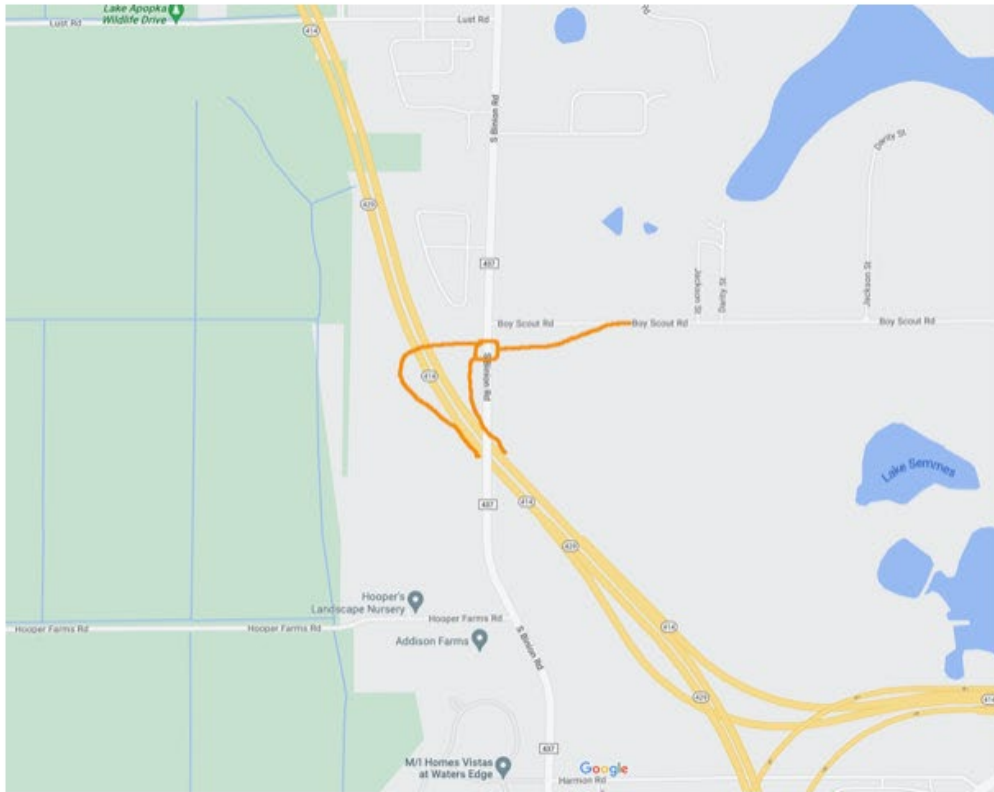
After talking with quite a few residents in the area regarding the proposed changes to this intersection, the vast majority of people express the same concerns that I do; Binion to northbound 429 and southbound 429 to Binion would be heavily under-utilized. The vast majority of traffic at both the 441/429 interchange and Ocoee-Apopka/429 interchange is traveling south on 429 or heading towards east 414 into Orlando. The current distance from Clear Lake Landing subdivision to 414/429 is 2.7 miles which is the closest access point to north 429, while it's 3.6 miles to Ocoee-Apopka/429 to head south. It's also 3 miles exactly to the Marden Rd entrance on 414 heading eastbound.

It is my belief that allowing traffic to flow to and from south 429 would alleviate growing traffic concerns at both Ocoee-Apopka/429 interchange as well as Marden Rd/Ocoee-Apopka which becomes very congested during rush hour due to that being the closest point for this side of Apopka to enter 414 east. I also do not believe that many people will utilize the current design coming from 429 south to Binion Rd over the current 441 exit since this new design would place a toll plaza at Binion while 441 does not have the additional toll at the current time, saving the few daily travelers a bit of money in exchange for maybe a couple of minutes of time. When looking at the Ocoee-Apopka/429 interchange, it appears the northbound entrance is already under-utilized as a result of the same issue, travelers can go to Marden Rd. to head east on 414 for less money and likewise at the 441 entrance towards the north while the southbound entrance off of Ocoee-Apopka remains heavily utilized on a daily basis. The ongoing development around the hospital and surrounding areas is just going to compound the issue, likely requiring upgrades to the southbound 429 interchange at Ocoee-Apopka that could be partially avoided by adding southbound access to the Binion plans.

Thanks for taking the additional time to review these thoughts and concerns, and while I'm not sure they will make any difference hopefully someone will take a second look at the project and current northbound access utilization before deciding to proceed with something that might benefit relatively few people compared to the alternatives.

Project Development & Environment (PD&E) Study: SR 429/Binion Road Interchange

In August 2022, CFX began a Project Development and Environment (PD&E) Study of the State Road 429/Binion Road Interchange. The study is evaluating a proposed half interchange (northbound entrance ramp and southbound exit ramp) expressway connection from Binion Road to SR 429 to provide enhanced access and mobility to southwest Apopka.

The study area runs along the vicinity of South Binion Road and Boy Scout Road at SR 429. Currently, drivers must enter and exit SR 429 by traveling approximately three miles north to just north of US 441 at the SR 429 Connector Road interchange or travel three miles south to the interchange at Ocoee Apopka Road.

The 6-month study will analyze intersection improvements and access management modifications along the proposed interchange.

When the PD&E Study concludes, it will result in a recommendation to the CFX Governing Board of the preferred alternative. If the project is approved by the CFX Governing Board, it would move forward to design and construction.
