PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Central Florida Expressway Authority is in the design phase of the State Road 528 (Martin B. Andersen Expressway) Capacity Improvements Project from State Road 417 (Central Florida GreeneWay) to Innovation Way. This 3.6-mile project will add one lane in the eastbound direction of SR 528 between SR 417 and Innovation way, expanding this portion of the expressway from two to three travel lanes.

This is one of three segments of the eastbound SR 528 Capacity Improvements Project between Goldenrod Road and Innovation Way.

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During this phase, surveying along the project corridor is done to assist in the design of the roadway, drainage systems, structures and lighting locations.


