PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Central Florida Expressway Authority (CFX) is in the construction phase of the State Road 528 (Martin B. Andersen Expressway) Capacity Improvements Project from Goldenrod Road to Narcoossee Road. This 1.8-mile project includes widening both the inside and outside lanes to accommodate an additional general use travel lane in each direction, widening the outside lanes to accommodate an auxiliary lane between the Goldenrod Road and Narcoossee Road interchanges, and widening the SR 528 bridge over Narcoossee Road to support a future 8-lane section. CFX will also be milling and resurfacing the roadway, updating striping and signage, and upgrading lighting as part of this project.

WHAT TO EXPECT

During construction, temporary lane and ramp closures will be necessary to accommodate construction activities. To minimize the impact on motorist traveling on SR 528, lane and ramp closures will not be permitted during peak travel times. Night and weekend work will also be required for this project.

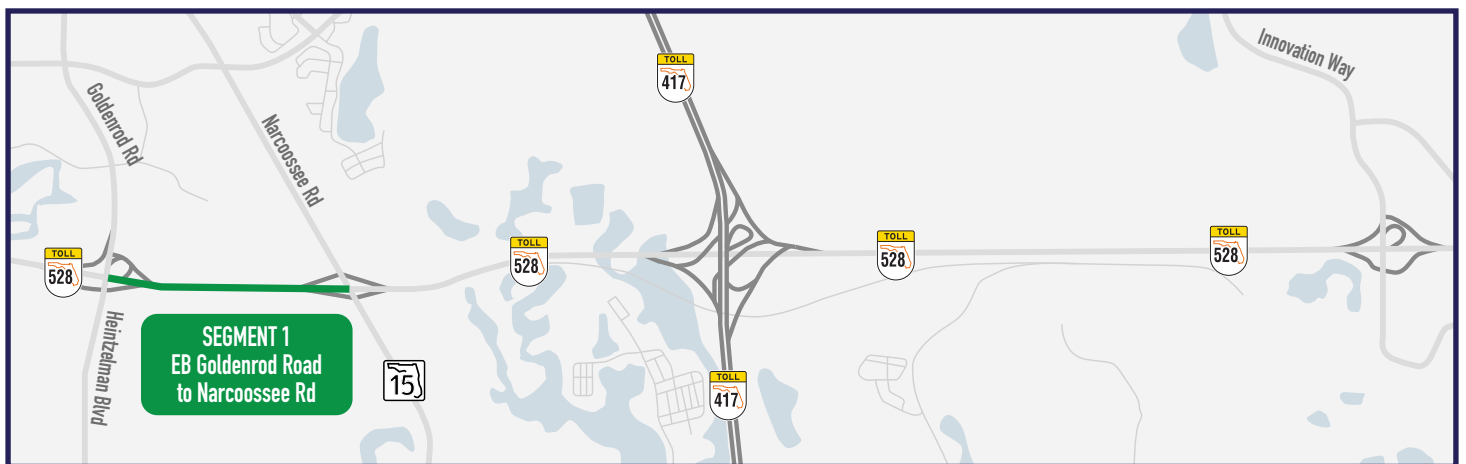

WORK ZONE SAFETY

For the safety of motorists and work crews, speed limits will be strictly enforced during construction. Speeding fines are doubled in work zones when workers are present. Motorists are reminded to change lanes for safety when they see Road Rangers assisting other motorists or flashing lights — it's Florida law.

The Central Florida Expressway Authority (CFX) is an independent agency of the State of Florida that operates and maintains a regional network of expressways for 3.6 million residents of Brevard, Lake, Orange, Osceola, and Seminole counties and more than 76 million annual visitors to Central Florida. CFX's 125-centerline mile, user-funded system includes 73 interchanges, 14 mainline toll plazas, 5 mainline gantries, 76 ramp toll facilities (includes six ramp gantries) and 365 bridges. On average, more than 1.6 million toll transactions are recorded daily, all of them electronically.
