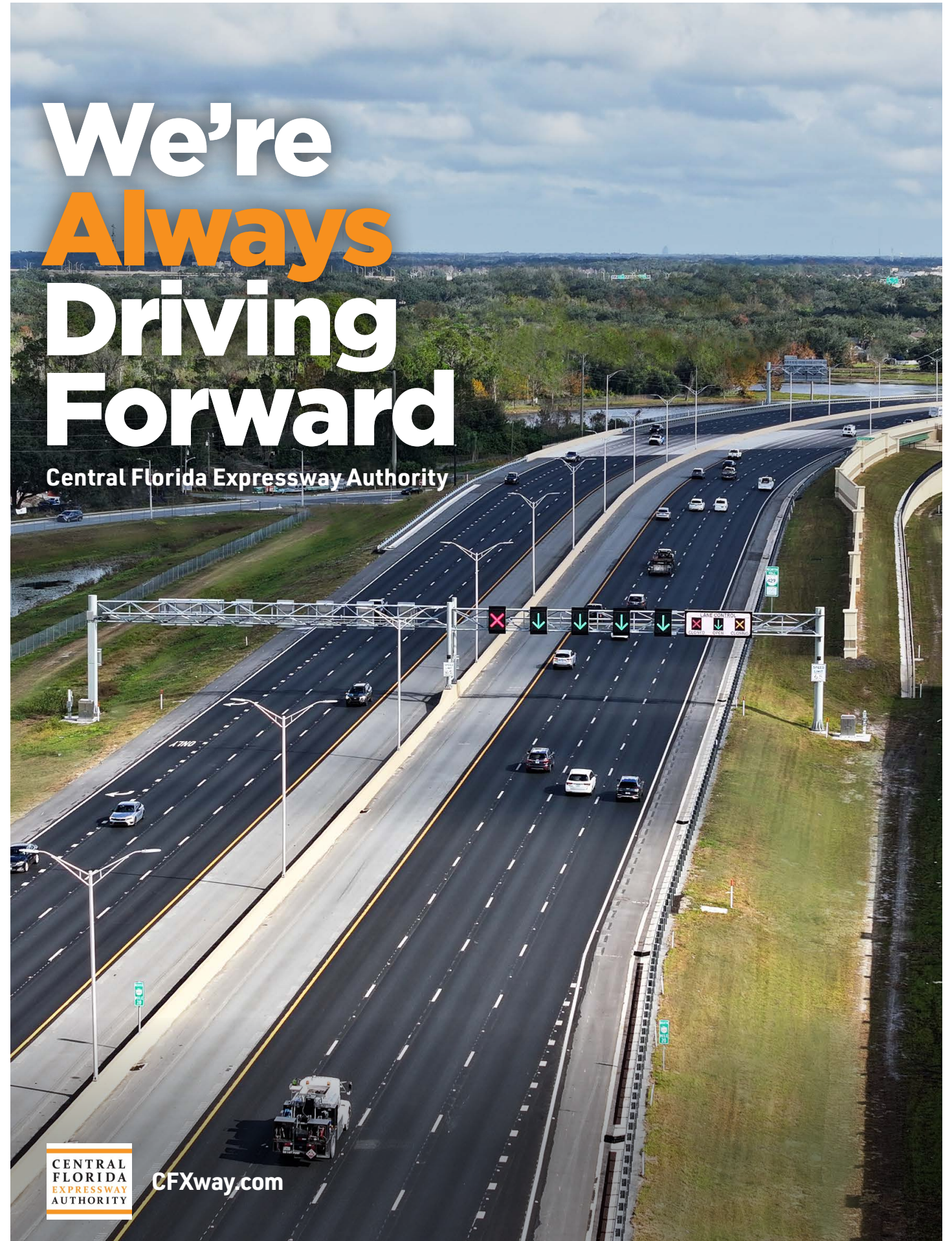
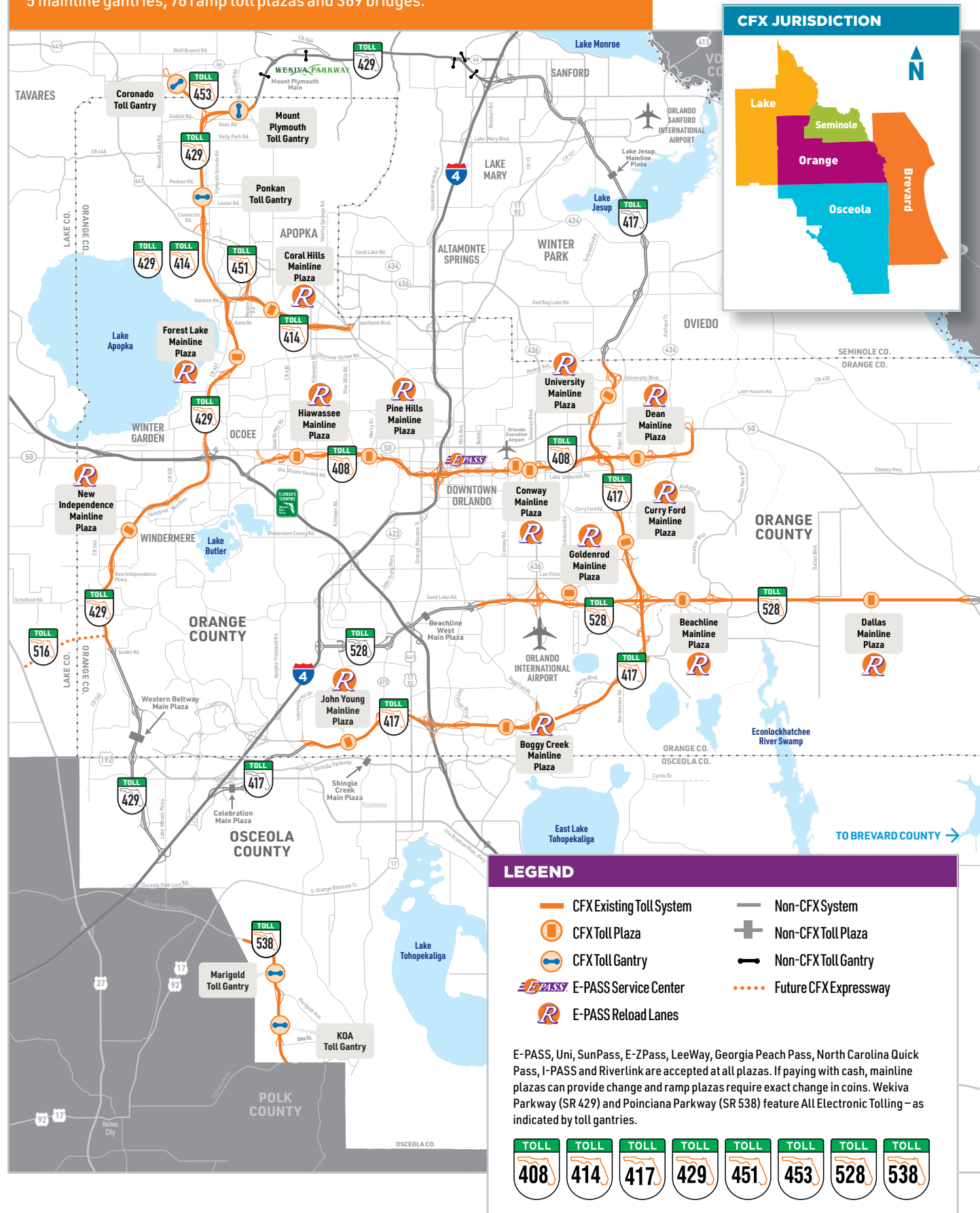


Central Florida Expressway System

For a Region on the Move

An independent, locally-controlled agency, **Central Florida Expressway Authority (CFX)** builds, maintains, and operates 125 miles of tolled expressways serving the transportation needs of more than 3 million local residents and 75 million visitors.

Funded exclusively by toll revenues and toll bonds, CFX was established to build and maintain a regional transportation network that connects Brevard, Lake, Orange, Osceola and Seminole counties.

As one of the fastest growing regions in the country, Central Florida's competitiveness depends on reliable and efficient movement of goods and people. CFX's expressways connect businesses, universities, attractions, and communities across the region. To keep pace with demand, over the next five years, CFX is investing \$4.2 billion into system improvements, enhancements, and expansion projects and studies.

Project Spotlight

Florida's First Flex Lanes

As Central Florida's population continues to grow, so does the demand on CFX roads. In 2024, the agency introduced Florida's first Flex Lanes, a dynamic solution for incident management and increased capacity.

The Flex Lanes use a wider median shoulder to allow traffic to continue flowing when an incident causes a closure in one or more of the right lanes. If a serious crash slows traffic, the Flex Lane will open to allow traffic safely past the crash at a reduced speed.

The system is controlled with dynamic overhead message signs that display a green arrow when the lane is open and red X to show lanes that are closed or when the Flex Lane is not in use. Digital speed limit signs advise drivers of the reduced speed when the Flex Lanes are operational. Activation of the Flex Lanes is done in partnership between CFX road crews and the area's Regional Transportation Management Center during an incident.

The Flex Lanes are part of the capacity improvement projects on State Road 417 and 429. In total, Flex Lanes technology is being installed on 22 miles of SR 417 and 13 miles of SR 429 in Orange County.

Governing Board

CFX is one of the few toll agencies in the nation where local elected officials represent the majority of its governing board. Maintaining local control puts customers and the local community in the driver's seat.

CFX's 10-member Board is made up of a county commission representative from Brevard, Lake, Orange, Osceola, and Seminole, the mayors of Orlando and Orange County and three governor appointees. Board meetings are televised and schedules are posted on CFXway.com.

CFX's commitment to regional connectivity and innovation can be seen in nearly every aspect of its project management, development and future planning.

Regional Economic Impact

CFX's Five-Year Work Plan has a substantial economic impact throughout Central Florida. The agency's \$4.2 billion Five-Year Work Plan is projected to contribute \$3.8 billion to local and state gross domestic product and add \$2.4 billion in wages and income in the Central Florida region, according to a report by the University of South Florida's Center for Urban Transportation Research.

Florida's Most Innovative Expressway

CFX's SR 516 Lake/Orange Expressway will provide a vital connection between two counties while preparing for emerging technologies. The nearly 4.5-mile project will

balance transportation needs with energy efficiency and nature by establishing a new wildlife tunnel, installing solar arrays, preserving a multi-modal corridor, and partnering with international and national organizations focused on shaping the future of transportation.

Award-Winning Zeroscape Landscaping

CFX is responsible for maintaining 10 million square feet – or over 175 football fields – of plantings. Wherever possible, CFX landscapes roadways with native species and has reintroduced species best suited to the local environment. These efforts produce real ecological and economic benefits through less mowing, fertilizing and weed control. More importantly, this approach to landscaping maintains, and even restores, Central Florida's natural environment, making it more resilient and adaptable, while improving habitat for thousands of native insects and animal species.

Florida's First Toll Pass

Since 1995, CFX has provided toll payment solutions through its prepaid toll program, E-PASS. With E-PASS, customers enjoy nonstop toll travel, exclusive toll savings, and a variety of toll pass options – including the free E-PASS sticker, now available in black.
