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# **SR 429 CORRIDOR CAPACITY** IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT:

**WEST ROAD TO SR 414** 

**EARLY 2025** 



#### **PROJECT** DESCRIPTION

The Central Florida Expressway Authority is widening State Road 429 (Daniel Webster Western Beltway) from West Road to State Road 414 (John Land Apopka Expressway) to reduce congestion and improve traffic flow. This 3.4-mile project will add a travel lane in each direction, expanding the expressway from four to six lanes (three travel lanes in each direction). Several noise walls are under construction; please see the map for the location of each wall.

CFX is also including wider median shoulders, called Flex Lanes, to help keep traffic moving and increase safety during times of significant incidents on the roadway. For more information about Flex Lanes, visit www.cfxway.com/flexlanes

### **WHAT TO** EXPECT

During construction, temporary lane and ramp closures will be necessary to accommodate work. To minimize the impact of construction to motorists traveling on SR 429, lane and ramp closures will not be permitted during peak travel times. There will be night and weekend work on this project.

### **WORK ZONE** SAFETY

For the safety of motorists and work crews, speed limits will be strictly enforced during construction. Speeding fines are doubled in work zones when workers are present. Motorists are reminded

to change lanes for safety when they see Road Rangers assisting other motorists or flashing lights — it's Florida law.
