
STUDY UPDATE

The Central Florida Expressway Authority (CFX) is continuing to conduct the State Road 515 Northeast Connector Expressway Phase 2 Project Development and Environment (PD&E) Study, which began in 2024.

This new 15-20-mile corridor would extend from Florida's Turnpike (State Road 91) northeast to US 192 and continue north toward the planned SR 534 expressway. Additionally, it's part of a broader regional mobility plan throughout Osceola County.

Following input from public agencies, community meetings, study area stakeholders, and additional corridor evaluation, CFX eliminated Corridor B from further consideration. Study analyses showed that Corridor B involved substantial impacts to existing communities and approved residential areas north of Lake Gentry as compared to the other corridors. The remaining three corridors (Corridors D, F and G), which are south of Lake Gentry, will undergo further study to evaluate and identify the recommended alignment that minimizes environmental and community impacts.
