STUDY UPDATE

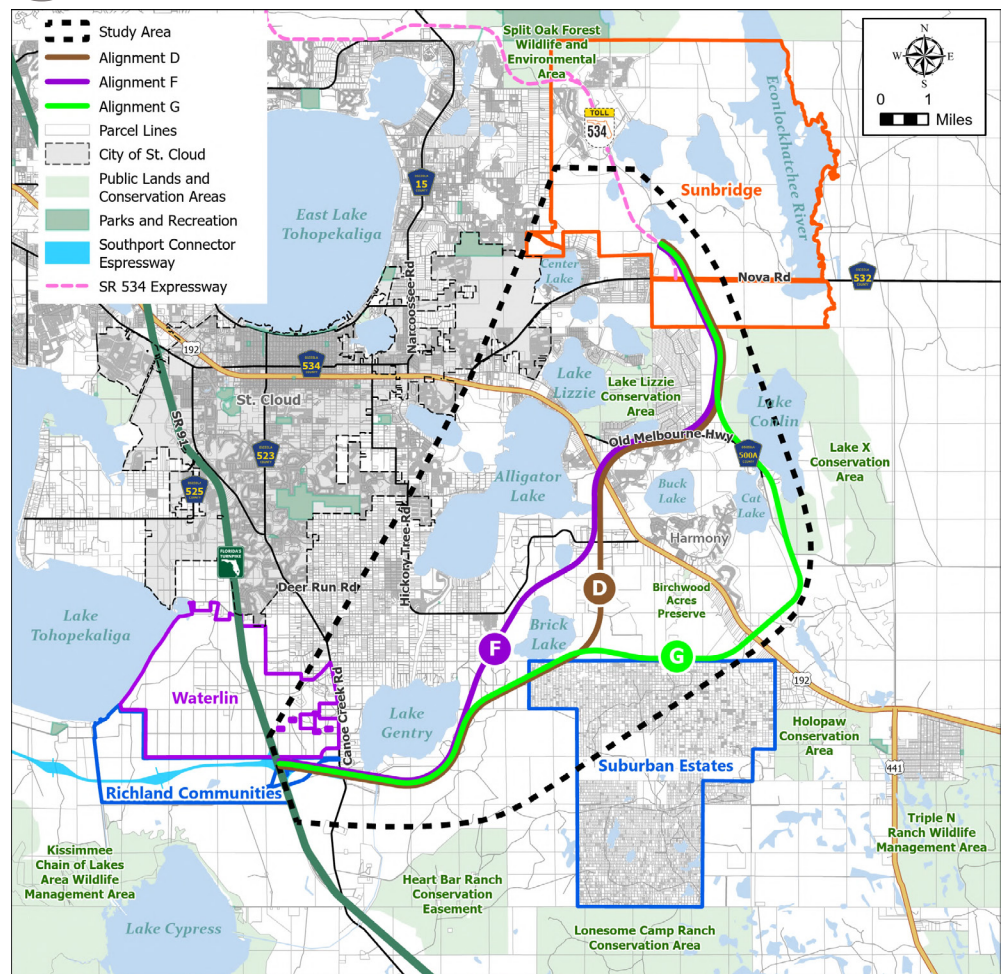
The Central Florida Expressway Authority (CFX) is continuing to conduct the State Road 515 Northeast Connector Expressway Phase 2 Project Development and Environment (PD&E) Study, which began in 2024.

This new 15-20-mile corridor would extend from Florida's Turnpike (State Road 91) northeast to US 192 and continue north toward the planned SR 534 expressway and Nova Road. The Northeast Connector Expressway is one of four projects identified in the long-term vision reflected in the CFX 2045 Master Plan. Together, the Northeast Connector Expressway, SR 534, Southport Connector, and the Poinciana Parkway Extension make up a southern beltway, which is a more than 50-mile expressway network in the southern region of Central Florida.

The study began with an Alternative Corridor Evaluation process, which used extensive input from agencies and the community to identify reasonable corridors for more detailed analysis. The Final Alternative Corridor Evaluation Report, on the study webpage, summarizes this analysis and identifies the three reasonable corridors (Corridors D, F and G) for further study as part of an alignment evaluation.

For each of these corridors, alignment alternatives were developed and analyzed to identify a recommended alignment that would best reduce environmental and community impacts. The results of this alignment evaluation, including the recommended alignment to advance for further refinement, will be shared with the community for feedback at the Alternatives Public Workshop planned for April 2026. Following this alignment evaluation, the recommended alignment will be further refined and detailed engineering and environmental studies will be conducted during the PD&E Study to identify the Preferred Alternative for input.

STUDY MAP



The Central Florida Expressway Authority (CFX) is an independent agency of the State of Florida that operates and maintains a regional network of expressways for 3.5 million residents of Brevard, Lake, Orange, Osceola, and Seminole counties and more than 75 million annual visitors to Central Florida. CFX's 125-centerline mile, user-funded system includes 73 interchanges, 14 mainline toll plazas, 5 mainline gantries, 76 ramp toll facilities (includes six ramp gantries) and 365 bridges. On average, more than 1.6 million toll transactions are recorded daily, all of them electronically. CFX operates E-PASS, the first electronic toll collection system in Florida, with more than one million E-PASS accounts. For more information, visit CFXway.com.
